What a wonderful day we had at Bamburgh on Thursday! The weather was extremely kind to us as we visited the Grace Darling museum and learned more about Grace's heroic achievements before moving to the churchyard at St Aidan's to visit Grace's family grave and memorial. The children even saw the cottages where Grace was born and died. We had lunch on the green in front of the castle - what a magnificent setting! Then we went into the castle moving through the state rooms, servants quarters and the dungeons. The armour and weapons in the keep was a particular highlight. Finally, we visited the lifeboat station at Seahouses where the children got a chance to learn about both the inshore boat and the all-weather lifeboat. The staff also gave the children a talk about how to keep themselves safe around water.
