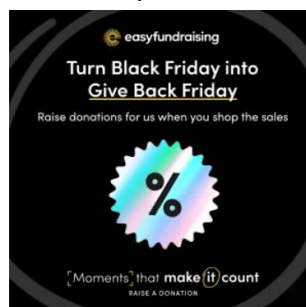
## **Christmas Fair - Friday 6th December**
