Lateral Flow Testing During half term

Schools have been advised by Public Health England and the DfE that they should continue to track and trace the contacts of any positive coronavirus (Covid-19) school cases at the beginning of the May half term holidays, up to 31st May. Therefore, we would be grateful if you would continue to inform us if your child tests positive during this period, so that we can respond appropriately. If we do have a positive case, we will ensure that the child's bubble is informed and dates for self-isolation are made clear.

It is very important that we have this information leading up to the school reopening on 7th June, as individuals who have tested positive or who need to self-isolate because they are a close contact of a positive case, must not return to school until their period of isolation is over.

We would like to ask that you support us in this. Our aim, as always, is to ensure the school is safe for pupils and staff, to minimise the risk of the spread of the virus, and to keep the school open for our children.
