School Dinners

From January 2023 the cost will be £2.35 per day, £11.75 per week. Children in Nursery, Year 3 and 4 are required to pay for school dinners whereas children in Reception, Year 1 and 2 receive Universal Free School Meals. This still represents good value for money for a hot meal and dessert for children and gives them the fuel they need on a school day. Dinner money can be paid either on a weekly basis each Monday or for the half term and payments can be put in the black post box on the yard or made at the school office.

Year 3 Multi skills Final

The children in Year 3 and 4 participated in the Northumberland Games Multi Skills County Final via Zoom in school today. They showed excellent commitment, enthusiasm and teamwork to complete the 5 challenges.
