- We will be focusing on number and place value before moving onto addition and subtraction within 19.
- We will be representing numbers to 10
 in different ways, finding 1 more and 1
 less than a given number and expand
 our mathematical language to
 understand terms such as equal,
 fewer, more, addition and subtraction.
- We will be exploring everyday materials
- We will be able to distinguish between and object and the material from which it is made.
- We will Identify and name a variety of everyday materials.
- We will describe the simple physical properties of different everyday materials and Compare/group together different everyday materials.

RE

- In RE we will be studying Christianity Our enquiry question is What do Christians believe God is like?' (Creation)
- We will also be learning about other faiths and Autumn festivals that are taking place.

As writers

- We will be applying our skills and knowledge from Read Write Inc to create amazing pieces of writing.
- We will have a focus on creating sentences and applying our phonics knowledge when writing.
- We will be writing for different purposes and about real events.
- We will be focusing on Traditional Tales to provide moral, cultural and ethical dilemmas for the class to discuss and learn from.
- We will use different Traditional Tales to inspire our writing and let our creative ideas flow!

- We will be able to locate London on a map and describe its location.
- We will be able to identify and describe the landmarks of I ondon.
- We will be able to use compass points and directional language to navigate between London's landmarks

Computing

 We will be learning how to be safe and responsible on the internet through rhymes and story books. We will learn how to use and act when using digital tools such as a computer and an TPad.

- We will be using our technical knowledge to create and construct a Car.
- We will be focusing on looking at the mechanisms of the Car, in particularly the wheels and axles.
