Inclement Weather Policy

Our School Ethos

Reflecting the Trust Deed, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.

In the event of the school having to be closed due to severe weather conditions the following procedures will be put into place.

The Headteacher / Teacher in Charge will contact and liaise with the School Caretaker and Office Manager. If it is deemed necessary to close the school the Headteacher / Teacher in Charge or Office Manager will use the school's code name to inform the local radio station who will broadcast that it is necessary to close the school, we will also inform Northumberland County Council so that it can be placed on their website.

All staff will be notified by the Headteacher / Teacher in Charge or Office Manager informing them of the closure of the school.

The Office Manager will proceed to contact parents / carers via emails and text messaging informing them of the school closure and requesting an acknowledgment to the message. The following email address has been set up especially for unforeseen events in order to be able to track acknowledgments from parents / carers. Notification will also be put on the school website / Facebook and Twitter pages.

Parents / carers are reminded periodically to make sure we have their up to date details and to also keep an eye out for messages during adverse weather conditions.

It is therefore very important that we ALWAYS have all staff / parents / carers up to date contact details e.g. mobile + home / work telephone numbers and email addresses.
