### Kindness Workshop

The children enjoyed a "Kindness Workshop" delivered by Emily from the School of Kindness at the charity 52 lives. We learned that kindness has three qualities – being friendly, generous and considerate. We also learned about the science of kindness and the positive impact it has on our physical and mental health. After watching videos of kindness in action, we practiced empathy and then said kind things to each other in the classroom. To put our kindness into action, we thought of someone we knew who could do with a little kindness. We then made them something in our classrooms and gave it to them. Finally, we looked at the quote 'be the change that you want to see in the world' and decided that we can help to create the kind of world we want to live in. Emily really enjoyed working with the children and was very happy they were so well engaged with the workshop and with their well-thought out answers and gifts they created.
