Tax Free Child Childcare

School is now set up as a Tax-Free Childcare Provider. If you use a tax-free childcare account, some other benefits can stop so please make sure you read the guidance on the [government website](#) before applying. If you are a working parent, you may be eligible to get a £2 top-up for every £8 towards the cost of your child care. You can find out more [here](#). Nursery Places – September 2026

If you, or someone you know of needs a nursery place for their child to start in September 2026, please consider recommending Tritlington to them. We are an Ofsted rated good school which offers a nurturing, caring environment. We set high expectations for behaviour and pupils achieve well letting their individual lights shine. You can obtain a form to enrol from the school office.

Pupil Premium/Free School Meals

It's simple and easy to see if your child is entitled to free school meals. This is not the same as universal Free School Meals, which every child is entitled to from Reception to Year 2. You will be able to access subsidised educational visits, free milk, subsidised clubs including Breakfast Club, as well as the school receiving £1500 per pupil which supports resources and staff for your child. The number to apply is 0345 600 6400 and they can check using your national insurance number to see if you are eligible. **Please help yourself and the school by giving them a ring, thank you.**

Community Library

On Thursdays from 3.15pm, you are welcome to come into school to visit the school library in the Rainbow Room with your child to share and select some books to borrow. We would love to see you there!

Tritlington Explorers is our wonderful after school wrap around care for children.

Please let the school office know **in advance** if your child would like to attend, so we can ensure the correct amount of resources are available.

- The cost is £4 per hour per child.



Example Costings for wrap around care:

- 3:15pm – 4:15pm = £4
- 3:15pm – 5:00pm = £7
- 3:15pm – 5:30pm = £9
- 3:15pm – 6:00pm = £11



Please note: Any collection after 6:00pm will incur a £10 late charge.
